

iGO is small in size, big on performance

Many grassroots and non-league football and rugby clubs, schools and local authority playing fields all have one thing in common; a need to mark out lines on playing surfaces. The problem however is that the current marking machines and more advanced paint formulations have been designed for the professional market, with the associated high cost.

All this has changed with the introduction of the iGO Mini marking machine and iGO Sport paint. A machine and paint combination specially developed for groundsman at all levels to apply professional quality lines at a low transfer price.

The iGO Mini is a line marking machine adapted from the top selling iGO spray marker used by top professional football and rugby clubs and at St George's Park, the FA National Football Centre.

The iGO Mini can apply paint to a range of natural and artificial surfaces. On grass,

the high-pressure delivery of the paint produces a consistent and uniform paint flow that covers both sides of the leaf blade in one pass, resulting in the application of bright white lines, time and time again.

Lightweight and compact, the iGO Mini machine is simple to operate and

easy to maintain with features such as a high-pressure pump, adjustable discs, pneumatic tyres, and a corrosion resistant, anodized frame. A re-chargeable battery is supplied and this can either be charged on the machine or easily removed and taken to a more convenient location.
