Exocet is a broad spectrum, systemic fungicide for effective disease control on turf and ornamentals. It is particularly effective against Fusarium, Anthracnose, Dollar Spot and Brown Patch.

HOW EXOCET WORKS

Propiconazole is a member of the DMI-fungicides group (demethylation inhibitors). These actives act against fungal pathogens inside the plant and stop disease development by inhibiting the biosynthesis of ergosterol which is a major component in the development of certain fungi.

Advanced formulation technology ensures the active ingredients are rapidly absorbed by the plant and systemically transported in the plant via the xylem, usually within one hour of treatment. This systemic translocation contributes to good distribution of the active ingredient within the plant tissue and ensures maximum protection throughout the plant thereby minimizing loss due to climatic or environmental causes.

Exocet offers a three-way route for the achievement of superb disease control. It has a fast action against a broad spectrum of diseases delivering preventative, curative and eradicant activity.

Exocet's micro emulsion, concentrated formulation mixes into a no-odour clear solution and provides excellent tank mix compatibility and stability.

HOW TO USE EXOCET

Apply 4 sprays per season as a preventative spray programme, when conditions become favourable for disease development. Applications should be made at minimum intervals of 14 days.

For optimum disease control, use Exocet in conjunction with turf management practices that promote plant health.

The suggested use period is April to October.
